



Looking After Our Village Church

Like any building that was built in the 14th/15th Century our Church needs constant repair and restoration. Even some of the features added in the 19th century are now needing attention.

Later this year we are to start restoration work at the west end of the Nave where the choir pews are unsafe because of rot, a new section of permeable floor tiles have to be laid and to stop further water damage we have to dig around the two west end pillars and fit new grating.

The total cost is expected to be around £20,000 and whilst we have been able to obtain some grants towards this cost we are still about £5,000 short. If you can support this work with any donation, large or small it will go a long way to help maintain our fine village Church.
